**Calendar: Show:** April 1, 2010 – June 30, 2010

**Registration Deadline:** March 1, 2010 – Submit this form, payment and a 4” x 6” photo of the entry.

Entries must be received by midnight on this date

**Notification of acceptance by email:** March 15, 2010

**Receiving:** Monday, April 1, 2010 4 – 5pm

**Artwork Pickup:** Thursday, July 1, 2010 4 - 5pm

**Entries:** Up to 2 artworks per applicant (entered photos of artwork will not be returned).

**Fees:** \$10 per application. Please mail in your check made payable to the Cupertino Library Foundation. No cash accepted. Thank you.

### Rules:

Artwork must not be removed until the last day of the show. No exceptions made.

The Cupertino Library and the Cupertino Library Foundation do not take commissions on paintings sold.

If the Artwork does not meet the framing standards specified below, it will be rejected from the show.

All Artwork must be removed by the prearranged time on the final day of the exhibition.

The Cupertino Advisory Panel on the Exhibit of Art in the Cupertino Library reserves the right to refuse to display any artwork that it considers inappropriate in any way.

The painting that is accepted cannot be substituted with another painting that has not been accepted.

### Eligibility:

Individuals who are eligible to submit artwork must be 16 years or older and include residents of Cupertino, students who attend schools within Cupertino including De Anza College, workers employed at Cupertino businesses, and current members of the Cupertino Fine Arts League and Euphrat Museum artists. Artwork should be your own original work. Renditions based on copyright protected sources used without permission of copyright holder are not eligible. Artwork not accepted to a show can be entered again in another show by submitting another copy of the photograph with the entry form. The following will **not** be eligible: Work that exceeds 36” (framed) in any dimension, Prints (except for photography and digital art), diptych, triptych or other multiple art, nudes, 3D art.

**Framing specifications:** Artwork will be rejected if it is not properly framed.

**The back of each painting should be labeled with title, price, media, artist’s name and phone number.**

All submitted work should be completely dry, properly framed and ready to hang.

Artwork on paper should be matted and framed in neutral colors. We recommend against using ornate heavy frames.

Plexiglas should be used for all framed art bigger than 24” in any dimension.

Oils and acrylics should be in a frame. Unframed canvas should be painted around the edges with no staples visible.

Wire: Only flat holders such as D-rings are accepted. Wire should be stretched **TIGHTLY** so that when hung it will not show above the frame. Wire should be attached 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the distance from the top of the canvas or frame.

The ends of wire should be taped to avoid injury while handling.
