Friends Host Annual Winter Book Sale in Cupertino Community Hall in February

The annual Winter Cupertino Used Book Sale, hosted by the Friends of the Cupertino Public Library, is coming soon. This popular sale will be held on Saturday and Sunday, February 20 & 21, 2010 in the Cupertino Community Hall located at 10350 Torre Avenue, between the Library and City Hall.

The Friends will have a large inventory of books and other media for this sale, considerably larger than most of the winter sales. A wide assortment of books, compact discs and VHS tapes, spanning all types of subject matter: fiction, non-fiction, travel, health, home and garden, romance, cookbooks, children's and young adult's books, reference, science, engineering, foreign languages, history, test prep, humor and many other topics, will all be sold at very low prices. There is also a separate "Select" area where special interest books on popular subjects are offered at slightly higher prices.

Sale hours are Saturday 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. and Sunday noon to 3 p.m. The children's book area is open only to children from 9 a.m. to noon on Saturday. The popular "Bag Day" is on Sunday where bags are sold for \$3.00 each and bag buyers

can fill up their bags from the remaining unsold, non-select books.
